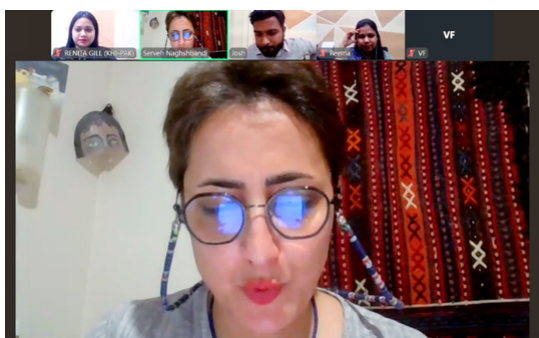

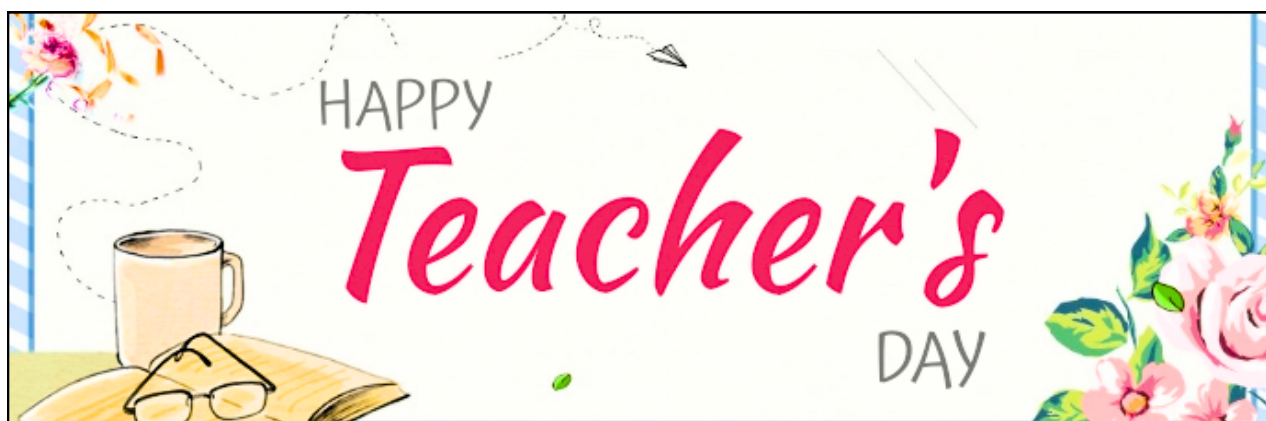

MONASH STILE PROJECT

The MONASH STILE Project, led by Dr. Venesser from Monash University, Australia, has been initiated in collaboration with CBE-K, Notre Dame Institute of Education (NDIE), and National Catholic Education Commission (NCEC). This collaborative initiative aims to strengthen literacy and numeracy learning outcomes in primary sections across participating schools.

The project focuses on enhancing teaching methodologies, integrating structured learning resources, and promoting interactive classroom practices to improve foundational skills among young learners. Through professional development, guided implementation, and continuous support, the initiative seeks to build teachers' capacity and ensure measurable academic improvement.
